

## 7 Things you Need To Know

about Being a Plaintiff in the Howard University Alumni Legal Complaint Against the Board of Trustees at Howard University

## The Howard University Plaintiff:

- 1. Must be an alum of Howard University (where they attended for at least one academic year). Proof of attendance is required by the existing body of plaintiffs. It is not required by any court.
- 2. Is *not* required to have graduated from Howard University.
- 3. Would be required to give their full legal name and postal mailing address, which would become a matter of public record on the legal complaint document.
- 4. Must be familiar and in agreement with the legal complaint. They must have also watched the videos that give insight into the complaint. This content can be found here: https://akilaworksongs.com/plaintiffs-against-howardu-2021
- 5. Must be able and willing to commit time, skills, and/or helpful resources toward the development of the plaintiffs' agenda. This may involve the following activities: attending plaintiff meetings, helping to organize and promote occasional town hall meetings, executing administrative tasks, reviewing documents from the attorney, and helping to promote the legal defense fund.
- 6. Would **not** be required to donate to the HU Plaintiffs Legal Defense Fund.
- 7. Would **not** be required to speak to the media about the lawsuit.
